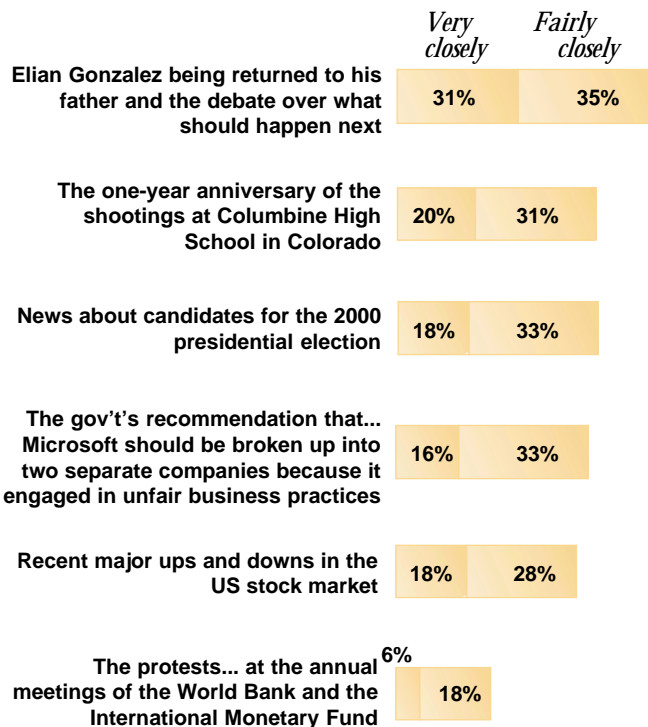


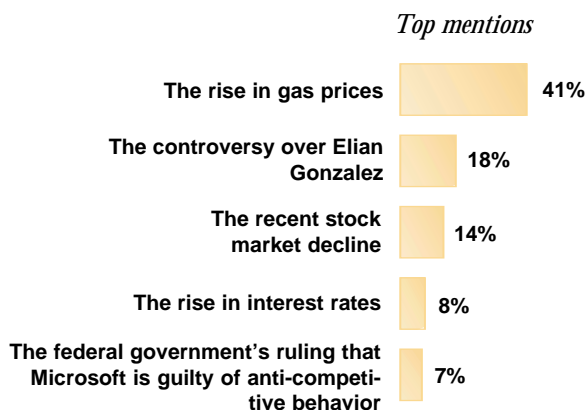
## News Interest Index

**Question:** Which one of the following recent new events has had the biggest impact on you personally?

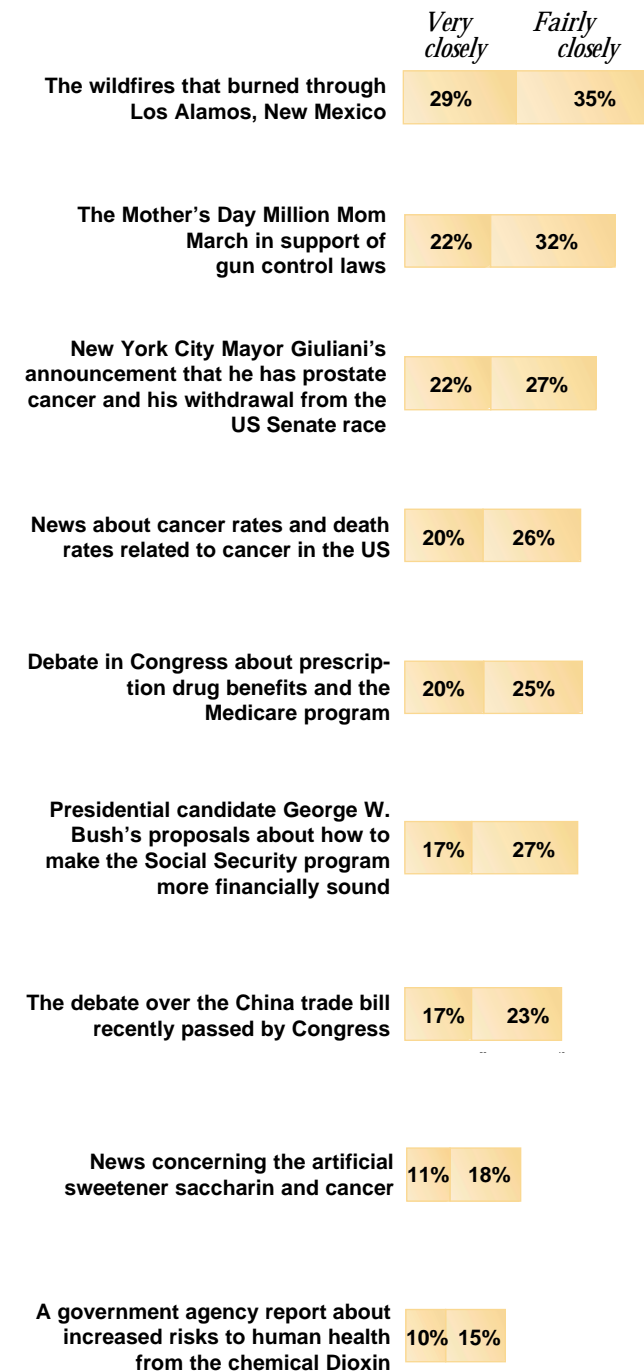

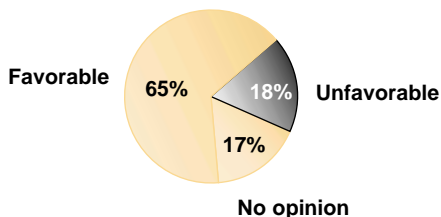

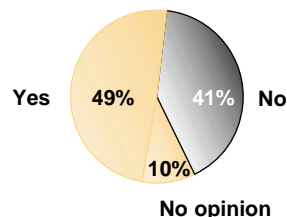
# Microsoft on My Mind

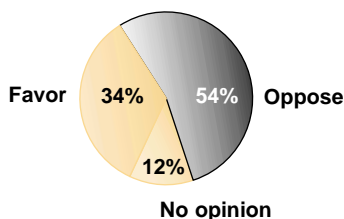

**Question:** Just your opinion, is Microsoft a monopoly or not?



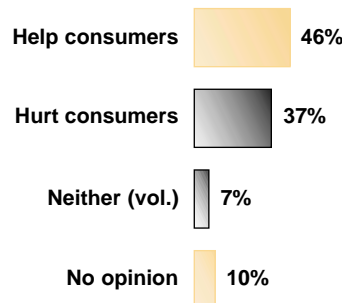

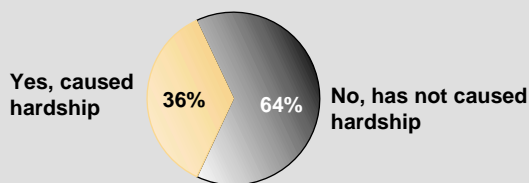
**Question:** Do you think the breakup of Microsoft into more than one company would help or hurt... consumers?

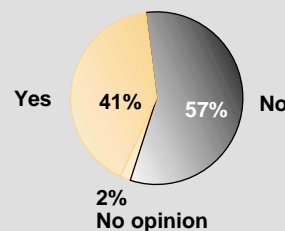
## I Think I'll Walk
