


## What to Wear (or Not Wear) On The Beach




Question: ...[T]ell me whether you have ever done it or not... gone swimming nude or "skinny dipping" with a mixed group?


### Most Americans Aren't Ready for the Riviera


Question: Have you ever gone swimming in the nude in mixed company?


Question: Have you ever gone topless on a beach?








