


Question: Would you describe the state of the nation's economy these days as excellent, good, not so good, or poor?





Question: If you had a thousand dollars to spend, do you think investing it in the stock market would be a good or bad idea?








Question: In your current job, do you receive... stock options or the opportunity to buy company stock?
