

Question: Please tell me which of these sports you follow...



## **Gridiron Glory**


**Question**: Would you say your interest in professional football has increased, decreased, or stayed about the same over the past five or so years?



Note: Asked of fans of professional football (66%).



**Question**: Do you consider the Super Bowl to be more of a sports event or more of an entertainment event?





**Question**: Which of the following sports championships is your favorite...?






