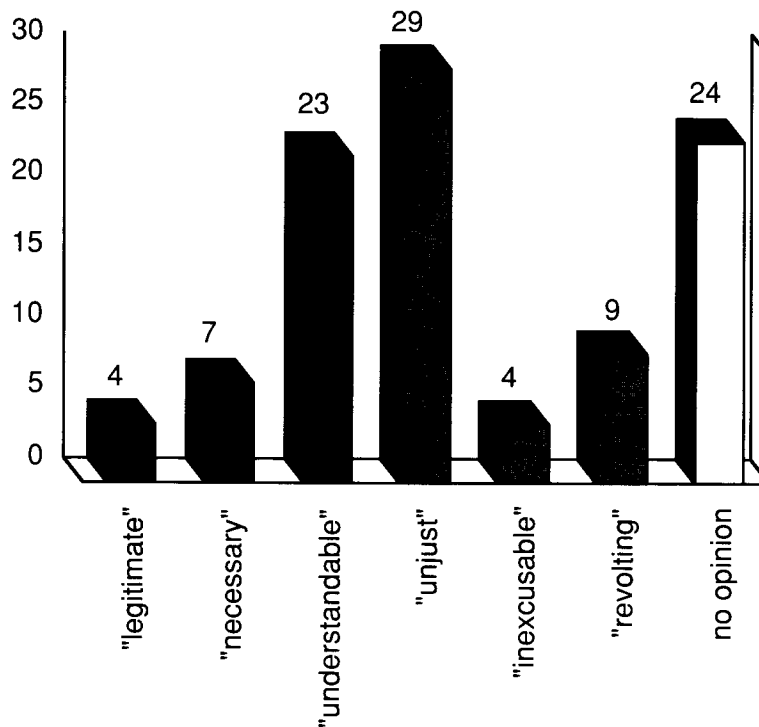


Ah, Louis, les Français Are Again... Changing French Views of the Monarchy and the Revolution

Question: How would you characterize the execution of Louis XVI on January 21, 1793?



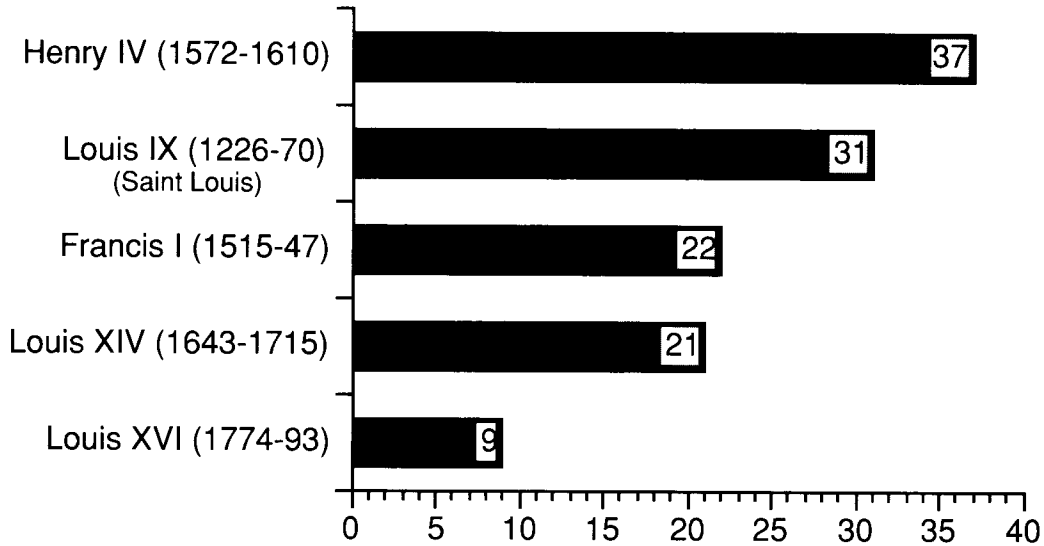
Question: Do you think that, in the history of our country, the monarchy played for France and the French people a very positive role, one somewhat positive, somewhat negative, or a very negative role?

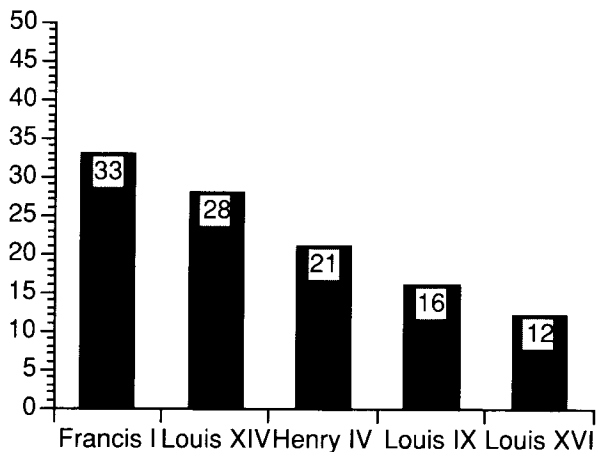
The Top Five Kings in French History Are:

Question: For which of the French kings do you have the most respect?

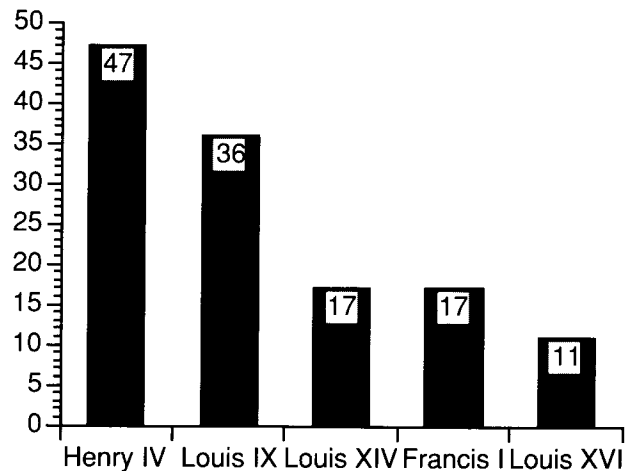


Changing Generational Perspectives
