
## Americans' Religiosity Is Strong and Unchanging



I don't know whether there is a God, and I don't believe there is any way to find out. I don't believe in a personal God, but I do believe in a Higher Power of some kind. I find myself believing in God some of the time, but not at others. While I have doubts, I feel that I do believe in God. I know God really exists and I have no doubts about it.

Note that the World Values Survey was done by the World Values Study Group, part of the Inter-University Consortium for Political and Social Research. The samples consist of adults age 18 and over, in 45 countries. The in-person interviews were conducted by local survey organizations. Sample sizes: varied from country to country. Questions 4 and 5 are from a cross-national survey done by the Gallup Organization for Applied Research in the Apostalate, 1981; question 6 is from cross-national surveys done for the Times Mirror Company.
