

Title: Polling in Practice: Analyzing Roper iPoll Data

Assignment: Evaluating a Roper iPoll Public Opinion Poll

Instructions:

Students are asked to:

- 1. Choose one Roper iPoll poll from one of these topics:
 - Healthcare access (e.g., attitudes toward government responsibility for health insurance/access)
 - Education quality (e.g., satisfaction with education quality in the U.S.)
- 2. Access the full poll details on the Roper Center Roper iPoll database.
- 3. Write a 2 to 3-page evaluation, including:
 - Poll description (who, when, sample, mode, topic)
 - Question wording analysis (neutrality, clarity, phrasing)
 - Sampling considerations (representativeness, limitations)
 - Findings interpretation
 - Critical reflection (e.g., potential effects of wording or timing)
- 4. Submit the paper along with the poll citation or a screenshot/URL.

- Wording critique 5 pts
- Sampling critique 5 pts
- Interpretation & reflection 4 pts
- Writing 2 pts
