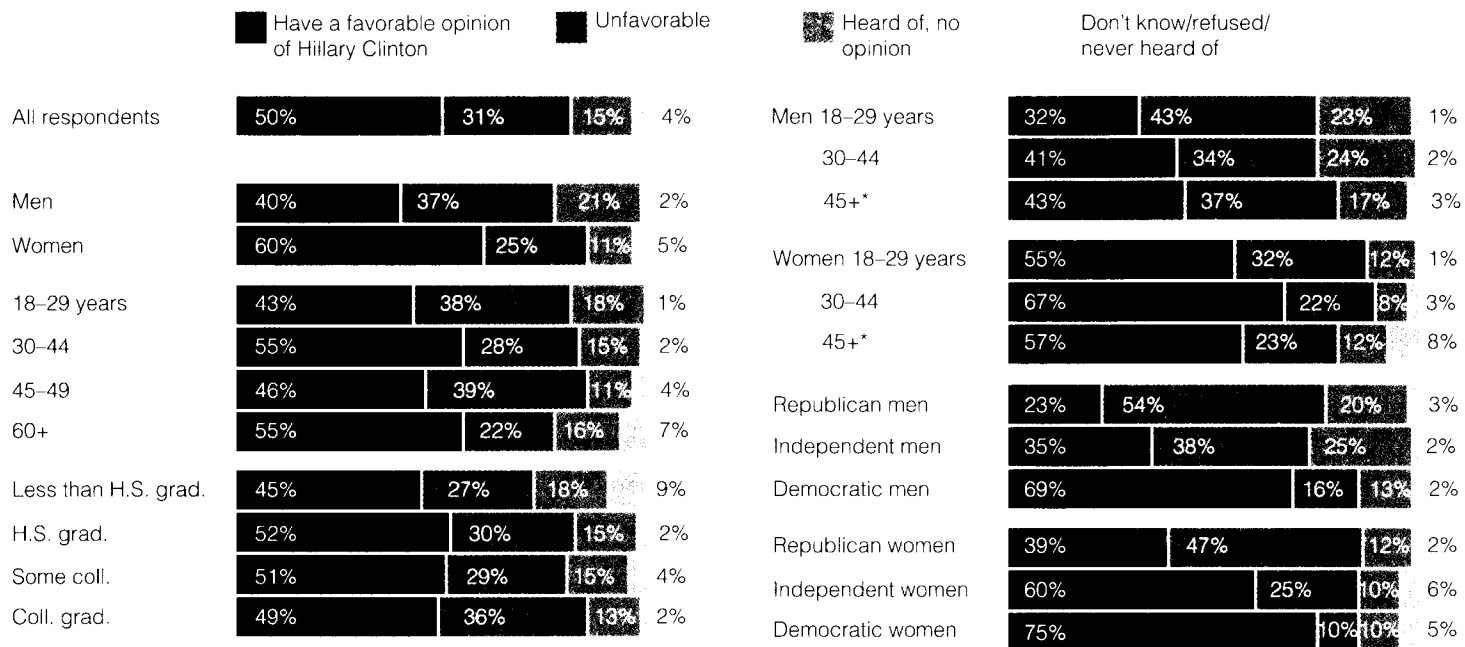


# HILLARY RODHAM CLINTON

This first lady's standing has been measured more often by more pollsters than that of any other presidential spouse. All polls show a similar progression for Hillary Rodham Clinton—increases in favorable ratings with a slight dip in some recent ones. There is a sharp gender gap in her support, with women considerably more supportive, and there are predictable political differences. Other group differences are minor.

I'd like you to rate your feelings toward each one as either very positive, somewhat positive, neutral, somewhat negative, or very negative. If you don't know the name, please just say so. (NBC News/Wall Street Journal); Next, I'd like your overall opinion of some people in the news. In general, do you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of...? (Gallup Organization); Is your opinion of Hillary Clinton favorable, no, unfavorable, undecided, or haven't you heard enough about Hillary Clinton yet to have an opinion? (CBS News/New York Times).
